On November 18 and 19, 2013, Hot 103, "Today's Hottest Music," executed a 25-hour, on-air Food Drive. With cooperation from many of the city's major supermarkets, the Hot 103 on-air staff collected donations of nonperishable goods, as well as a generous donation of 30 turkeys. Following the food drive, the Hot 103 staff delivered the donations to the Roadrunner Food Bank, where they proceeds weighed in at 1,059 pounds of food and \$340 in cash donations.

On December 3 and 4, 2013, the attention turned to a 24-hour, on-air Toy Run. Staged at many of the city's major retailers, the Hot 103 on-air accepted new, unwrapped toys. The net efforts were an overflowing box of toys and \$425 in cash donations for the Las Cruces Chapter of the Marine Corps Toys For Tots Foundation.

Program Director Damien Willis headed up the effort to give back to the community. "The radio station group had been involved with Toys for Tots for years," Willis said, "The Hot 103 staff wanted to take it a step further, so we added the Food Drive. The outpouring of support from the community is what made it a success. We can't thank them enough."
