How to upload your awards:

Be sure to be prepared by having your entries organized before you start. Here's what you'll need to know:

- » the name of the category
- » the call letters of the radio station
- » the title of the entry
- » the names of the people who should be recognized for this award*
- » the mp3 file containing your entry or the URL link to your entry

*THIS IS IMPORTANT - Names and spelling will be on the actual award, so be sure you've got everybody... and spelled correctly.



STUDENT DIVISIONS

Student Division is open to any student in New Mexico affiliated with a member radio or television station. Entry must be submitted by a station/school.

GENERAL RULES

Any student affiliated through a class, seminar or extracurricular activity at a broadcast station that is an NMBA member is eligible to submit entries.

Entries must have been broadcast within the immediate-past academic year. Each entry must have been broadcast on the affiliated station that is a current member of the NMBA and broadcast within the state of New Mexico.

Student awards may only be awarded in the student division. Students who enter in the Student Division, may not compete in the larger Radio or Television Divisions.

Student entries are limited to three per category and must be submitted as originally broadcast (unless otherwise noted).

All entries must be uploaded on the official NMBA awards website. All entry fees must be paid prior to judging. The student fee per entry for \$25.

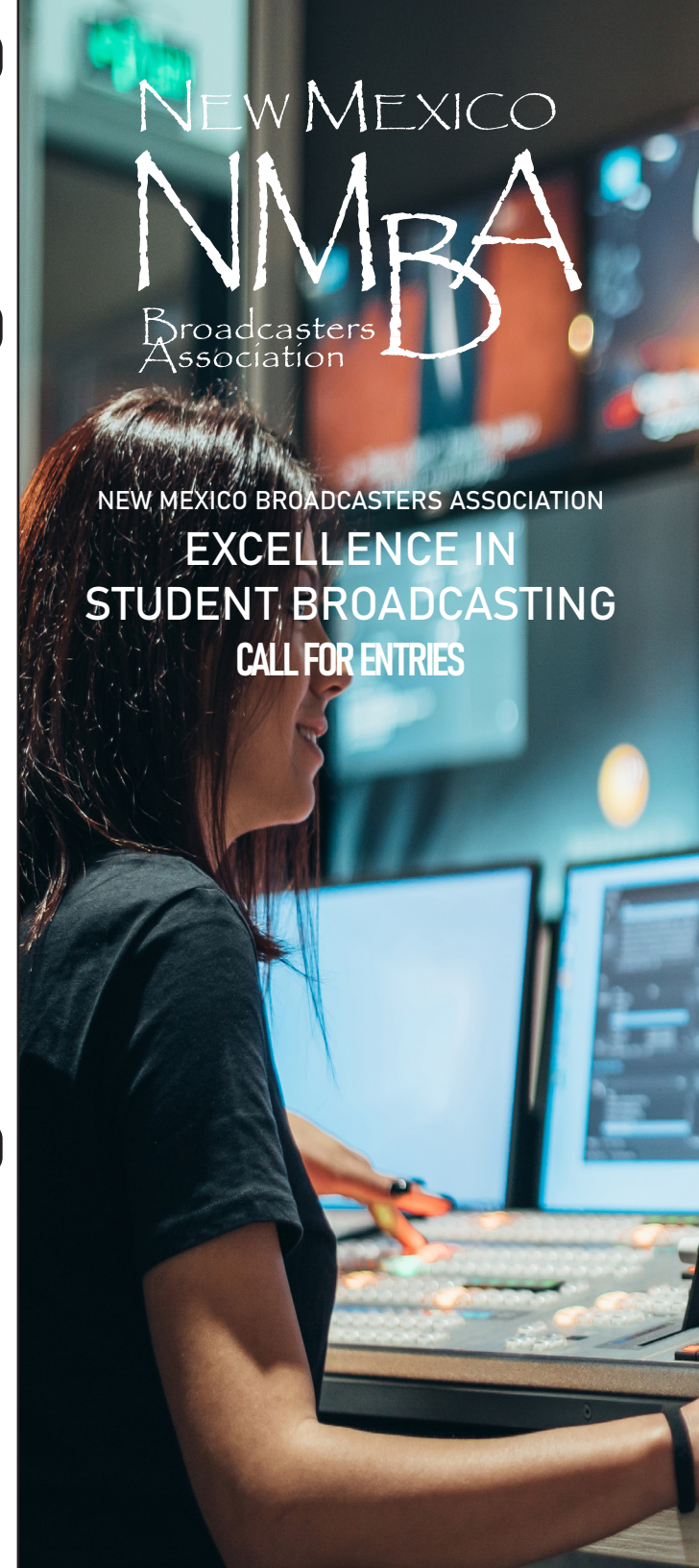
The NMBA uses RockOurAwards.com to streamline the upload process. For returning stations, simply visit rockourawards.com, login using your previously created username/password and start uploading.

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

The following award categories are for individual achievement.

Student News Reporter: Judging criteria includes ability to create news content, clarity, accuracy and depth of coverage, while explaining stories in a unique, complete and exciting manner. Entry must not exceed 10 minutes.

Student Feature Reporter: Judging criteria includes ability to create relevant feature content, clarity, accuracy and depth of coverage, while explaining stories in a unique, complete and exciting manner. Entry must not exceed 10 minutes.

Student Sportscaster: Judging criteria includes demonstration of an overall excellence in sports reporting, overall presentation, creativity, accuracy, fairness and clarity. Entry must not exceed 10 minutes.

Student Weathercaster: Judging criteria includes compelling delivery, use of technology, and ease of translating technical meteorology terms and concepts to a general audience. Entries must not exceed 10 minutes.

Student Video Essay: The video essay creator is the photographer and editor, weaving together elements captured in the field to tell the story without a reporter or professional talent track. Entry must not exceed 10 minutes.

Student Videography: Entry must be a compilation of work that best represents the student's capabilities utilizing creativity, continuity, lighting, and technical production. Entry must not exceed 10 minutes.

Sports Play by Play: Play-by-play coverage of a single sports event. Submit six minutes of unedited play-by-play material announced by students.

Student DJ Personality: Judging criteria includes entertainment value, creativity, production value, presentation and impact. No syndicated programs. A maximum of 10 minutes without commercials.

TEAM AWARDS

Student Newscast: Entry may be from any regularly scheduled newscasts. Judging criteria include presentation, production value, interest of story, and overall impact of the newscast. Submit entire newscast without commercial breaks.

Student Sports Report: Judging criteria include significance, presentation of facts, delivery and/or creativity, entertainment value, and effective use of video and audio. Entry must not exceed 10 minutes

Original Production: Original student production criteria include significance to audience, resourcefulness, comprehensiveness, and production values. Entry must not exceed 10 minutes.

Commercial or PSA: Must have been written, produced and voiced by students. Judging criteria include creativity and effective messaging. Entries may not be longer than :60.

Social Media Use: This award honors responsible use of social media in connecting to your community. In 200 words or less, entry should describe how broadcast content was modified and enhanced for social platforms, and how the cross-platform approach worked to create a unifying message and succeeded in meeting its goals.
